

What is Community Legal Education (CLE)?

Community legal education aims to make people aware of the law, their rights, and the way the legal system works. It aims to improve people's capacity and skills in dealing with legal issues they may face.

Community legal education aims to meet the priority needs of target groups and communities.

Community Legal Education (CLE) includes:

- giving information to a person, people, a group or an organisation about the ALS
- giving information about legal issues, how the system of law works, and how to access the ALS
- handing out ALS brochures, Fact Sheets, short films, etc
- holding a stall for the ALS
- attending community, interagency and service provider meetings as a representative of the ALS
- relationship building with other service providers through meetings, attending events and having partnerships in events and CLE
- giving a paper or presentation at a conference or a meeting
- emailing local stakeholders with ALS and/or legal-related information
- facilitating a workshop on a particular area of law
